## C LEVEL

## READING WORKSHOP = 20\% of grade

- Complete $75 \%$ of your reading goal which is $\qquad$ pages.
All reading material must be at or above your reading level.
- Read at least 1 book from the challenge book list or approved as challenging by the teacher.
- Complete a book talk after each book you have read in order to make the pages count
- Read a book set in Asia
- Read a minimum of two hours per week at home.


## WRITING WORKSHOP $=\mathbf{2 0} \%$ of grade

- Complete a 1 page Choice Piece to the C level on the rubric, using the typing guidelines. Show evidence that you went through the entire writing process.
- Presentation of Choice Piece
- Complete your Hero Paper in Explore utilizing required techniques
- Complete a Writing Portfolio for 1st semester pieces.
- Complete the class blog according to the C level on the rubric.
- Complete and participate in mini-debate/research/non-fiction unit (prep for 4th Quarter)


## B LEVEL

READING WORKSHOP = 20\% of grade

- Complete $85 \%$ of your reading goal which is $\qquad$ pages.
All reading material must be at or above your reading level.
- Read at least 2 different genres.
- Read at least 1 book from the challenge book list or approved as challenging by the teacher.
- Complete a book talk after each book you have read in order to make the pages count
- Read a book set in Asia
- Read a minimum of two hours per week at home.


## WRITING WORKSHOP = 20\% of grade

- Complete a 1.5 to 2 page Choice Piece to the B level on the rubric, using the typing guidelines.

Show evidence that you went through the entire writing process. The piece may not be longer than 3-3.5 pages in length.

- Presentation of Choice Piece
- Complete your Hero Paper in Explore utilizing required techniques
- Complete a Writing Portfolio for 1st semester pieces.
- Complete the class blog according to the B level on the rubric.
- Complete and participate in mini-debate/research/non-fiction unit (prep for 4th Quarter)


## A LEVEL

READING WORKSHOP = $20 \%$ of grade

- Complete $95 \%$ of your reading goal which is $\qquad$ pages.
All reading material must be at or above your reading level.
- Read at least 2 different genres.
- Read at least 2 books from the challenge book list or approved as challenging by the teacher.
- Read a book set in Asia
- Complete a book talk after each book you have read in order to make your pages count
- Read a minimum of two hours per week at home.


## WRITING WORKSHOP = 20\% of grade

- Complete a 2.5 to 3.5 page Choice Piece to the A level on the rubric, using the typing guidelines. Show evidence that you went through the entire writing process. The piece may not be longer than 3-3.5 pages in length.
- Present Choice Piece
- Complete your Hero Paper in Explore utilizing required techniques
- Complete a Writing Portfolio for 1st semester pieces.
- Complete the class blog according to the A level on the rubric.
- Complete and participate in mini-debate/research/non-fiction unit (prep for 4th Quarter)

DAILY WORK all contract levels = 20\% of grade

- Complete all daily assignments to the best of your ability
- Participate appropriately in class
